- ~ Complete ONE Honors/AP class in the desired discipline.
- ~ Complete TWO additional classes within the desired discipline.
- ~ Complete ONE additional VAPA class (this class does not need be in the desired discipline).
- ~ Complete a minimum of 10 volunteer service hours per year (in addition to any other MHS service requirements).
- ~ MUST earn a C or better to receive Conservatory credit for each required class.
- ~ Complete and submit an approved Capstone Project.
